Dr. James W. Ellor is the director of the Center for Gerontological Studies in the School of Social Work at Baylor University in Waco, Texas. He also serves as the Editor-in-Chief of Pastoral Press and editor of the Journal of Religion, Spirituality and Aging. He earned his Ph.D. and his D.Min. degrees at the Chicago Theological Seminary.

Dr. Ellor works with older adults around issues of mental and spiritual health. He has served on the executive committee of the Midwestern Geriatric Education Center, and also provides education, counseling, and planning for individuals and groups who work with seniors.

Dr. Ellor has done research work in entrostomal therapy, hunger, spiritual assessment and intervention techniques with cognitively impaired older adults.

Faith in Action Caregivers is fortunate to be able to offer the Austin Metropolitan Religious Community the opportunity to meet Dr. Ellor. We believe that everyone will leave this conference with a better understanding of the isolation and loneliness issues impacting our senior neighbors--and how individual congregations in Austin can help to address this growing problem.
